## Budget 2020: BSA Scotland Summary

### Key Points

As part of today's Budget the Government has made the following announcements.

### Scotland

- Scottish Government's block grant will increase by over £640 million through to 2020-21 before adjustments for tax devolution
- £25 million for Argyll and Bute Growth Deal
- Package for the whisky industry
- Up to £2 million for Ofgem to secure new premises in Glasgow
- Funding for the Shared Rural Network agreement to improve mobile coverage in rural areas, and £5 billion investment in gigabit broadband rollout in the hardest-to-reach areas of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland
- UK Shared Prosperity Fund: At a minimum, it will match current levels of funding for each nation from EU structural funds. The government will set out further plans for the Fund, including at the CSR.
